Confucius Classrooms are schools across England that have Chinese firmly embedded in their curriculum and can give advice, support and taster classes to other schools in their region who are looking to start the teaching of Mandarin.

The award is given by the Confucius Institute: (Chinese: 孔子学院; pinyin: Kongzi Xuéyuàn) a no profit public educational organisation affiliated with the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, There are now approximately 100 Confucius classrooms in the UK with the aim to promote Chinese language and culture, support local Chinese teaching and facilitate cultural exchanges.

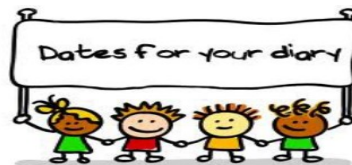
